

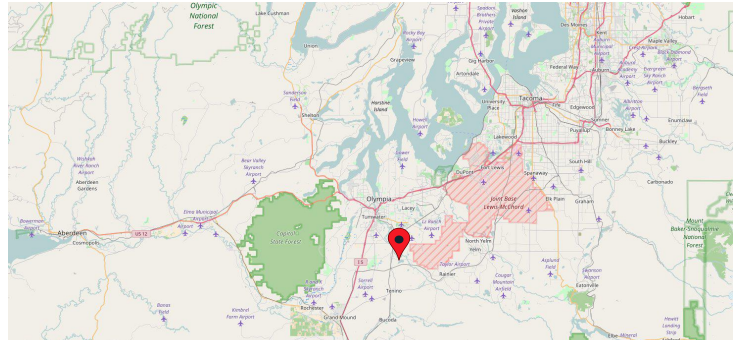
# Olympia

We visited the Washington State Capital Museum and the local market. The Museum is open Wednesdays through Saturdays from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.. Admission is \$2 for adults and \$1 for kids. Family tickets are \$5. The museum is closed for renovation for an unknown temporary time.
