

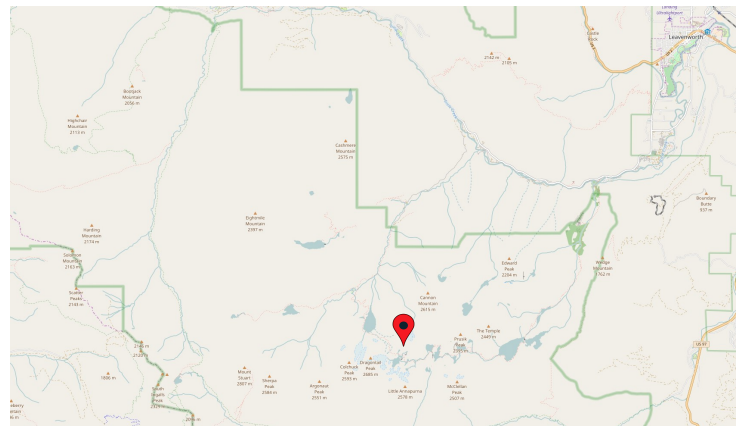
Colchuck hike

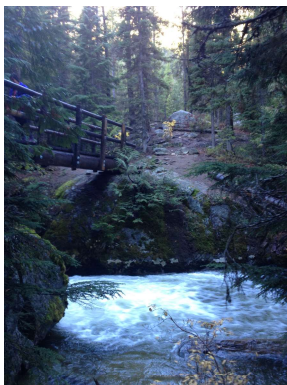
Hike

What was nice:

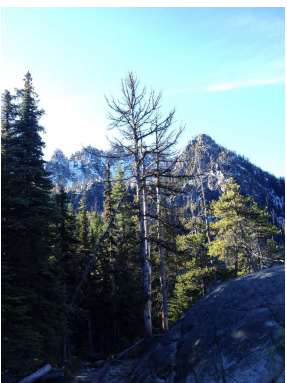
