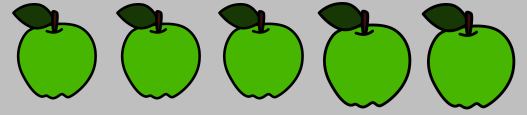


# Helicopter flight

A wonderful hike along and across the river for children and adults



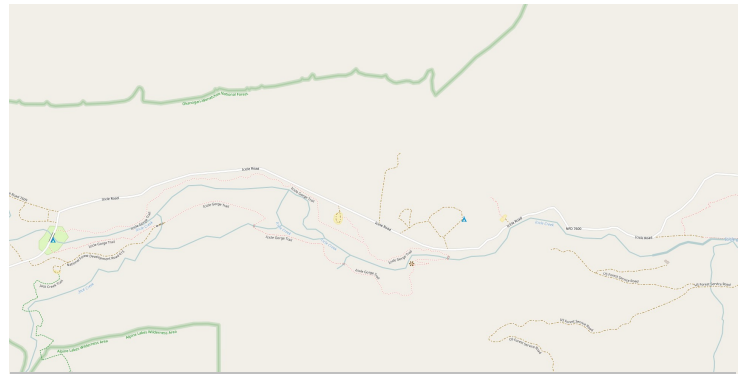
