


The Facts: The Seattle Center Monorail is an elevated monorail line in Seattle, Washington, that operates along Fifth Avenue between Seattle Center in Lower Queen Anne and Westlake Center in Downtown. Seattle Center Monorail is a public transport driving HAD with a top speed of 45 mph (72 km/h). The monorail is owned by the City of Seattle and opened on the 24 March in 1962.


